Wearable Art Competition Rules

1. Entrants must be NCQSI 2011 participants registered for a minimum of ONE class or lecture.
2. Categories include: **Garment:** vest, jacket, coat, cape, dress, skirt, blouse, jumper. **Accessory:** hat, purse/bag, scarf, tie, detachable collar or belt.
3. A participant is permitted only one entry per category, with a maximum of two entries. Each entry must have its own entry form.
4. **All wearable art competition entry forms must be received by April 24th, 2011.**
5. Any item entered in a previous NCQS Quilt Show or Fashion Show is *not eligible* for entry. All items entered must have been completed on or after January 1st 2006.
6. The entry must be entirely the work of the entrant.
7. Garment items entered must have a cloth label with name, address and phone number sewn inside. Accessories must have either a cloth label or a paper labels firmly attached to the item. The label must include name, address and phone number.
8. Entry must include one or more of the following techniques: quilting, appliqué, piecing, decorative stitching, needle felting, beading or other embellishment.
9. Entries must be **received** at the address on the shipping form by May 21st, 2011 or delivered in person on May 19th 2011, to the Capital Quilters Guild meeting between 7:00pm to 9:00pm (Temple Beth Or, Congregational Hall, 5315 Creedmoor Road, Raleigh, NC 27612-6306). You will receive a claim form/entry number in the mail. The entry portion must be attached to the entry. Retain the claim portion to retrieve your item at the end of the show on Sunday June 5th.
10. Items will be shown in the Participants' Fashion Show on Friday night, June 3rd, and then returned to the quilt show area for display for the remainder of NCQS11.
11. Claim forms (see rule 9) are needed to retrieve your garments between 1:00 and 2:00 pm on Sunday, June 5th, 2011 at the Peace College Gymnasium.
